TERMINALLY ILL ADULTS (END OF LIFE) BILL- The Bill now proceeds to the House of Lords for further scrutiny and debate. As you know, Archbishop John has consistently raised his voice in defence of the most vulnerable. In response to Friday's vote in the House of Commons, he stated that the result marked "a terrifyingly dark week in British history, as MPs vote for legislation which endangers the lives of unborn children, and promote legislation which will endanger vulnerable adults and the elderly."
